How it All Started for Mike

- ▶ Dirt Bike Late 70's and 80's
 - Riding motorcycles since 14 yrs old
 - Competed in Desert Races in New Mexico
 - “Oh My God” podium finisher in Expert Class

- ▶ Stock Car
 - Raced local at Duke City
 - Bought a claimer car after the races one night
 - Hit everything on the track except the flagman

1983 Won back 2 back 100 mile dirt races



Sprint Car 1987-1992

- ▶ Raced local at Duke City in Albuquerque, NM
- ▶ Traveled to different States multiple times
 - Manzanita Speedway in Phoenix, Arizona
 - El Centro, California
 - Yuma, AZ
 - Tucson, AZ
 - Pueblo, Colorado
 - Denver, CO
 - Amarillo, TX



- ▶ Met Al Unser Jr, Owen Snyder and the Gallas race team for the Indy 500



Racing with the Best

- ▶ Raced with the World of Outlaws made several “A” Features.
- ▶ Went to Manzanita for the 1st time.
- ▶ Won a B feature in Denver with the Outlaws.
- ▶ Was racing on TV for the 1st live broadcast at the Slick 50.



Started in Mini Sprints 1994–current

- ▶ 1996–Drove House car for Bailey Chassis Dealer
- ▶ Has over 50 mini sprint wins

 - Started racing the Quarter Midget division in Jr. novice at the biggest race of the year
 - Thunder on the Mountain in Phoenix, AZ



2002–2003 Hodges Racing

- ▶ Moved up to the Sr. Honda division
 - Drove for Jack Hodges in the team car
 - Picked up several wins in both seasons



2004–2006 Asphalt Mini Sprints

- ▶ 1st Year in Mini Sprints at 14 years old
- ▶ Won the Heat and the Main in 1st race
 - Car owner let me keep driving
- ▶ 3rd in Championship points ('04 & '05)
- ▶ Received my Black Belt that same year

Indianapolis 500 in 2008

- ▶ Went with Dillion Tanner who is Al Unser Sr. Grandson
- ▶ Went to Joe Devin's Race car shop
 - Took us with Dustin Morgan to Terre Haute (USAC)
- ▶ Visited TSR with Jay Drake, Met the owner of Beast Chassis, and Drove the speedway.



2009–current Dirt Mini Sprint

- ▶ Was surprised with my 1st brand new car



Manzanita Speedway

- ▶ It was our first race with the brand new cars
- ▶ This race was with the World of Outlaws
- ▶ This was the very last race at this Track before it closed



2010 and 2011 Champion

- ▶ Won back to back New Mexico Mini Sprint Championships
- ▶ Was the top winner on the Hyper Chassis website with 15 wins in 24 races

Tulsa Shootout Opportunity



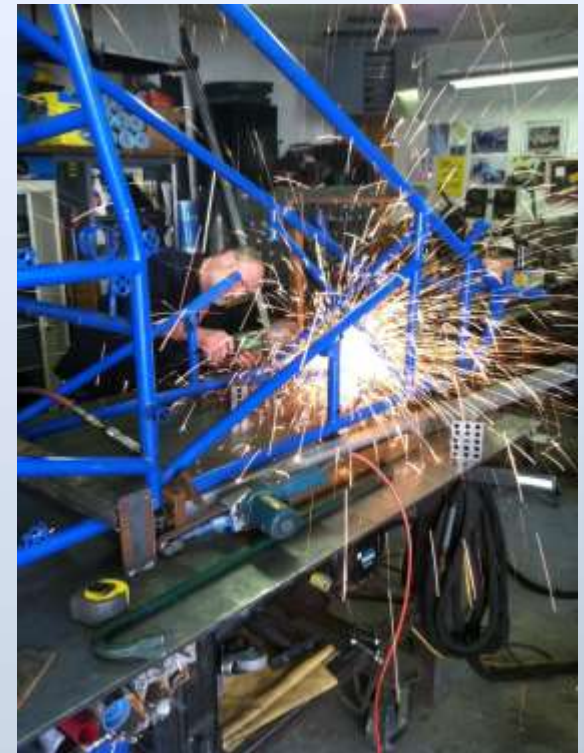
Tulsa Shootout 2010-2014
