

GATORNATIONALS BUS TRIP

Our club will be able to resume our bus trip to the Gatornationals, Gainesville Raceway again on March 11, 2022. Our last two attempts were affected by COVID. Tickets and the bus are all now confirmed. If you would like to go, the cost for bus, pit pass and reserved seat is \$70. We have a limited number of tickets if you wish to drive yourself. This ticket will only cover your reserved seat and pit pass. Contact me for cost of these tickets.

You do not need to be a member of the club, so you can ask your neighbors, friends, relatives. The tickets we receive are on the pit side of the track so you can go into the pits, take pictures, talk to drivers and crew members, and just see the behind-the-scenes activity of this NHRA race.

The bus will arrive at the Lake Sumter Transportation Station at 8:30AM. Please be there around that time so we can load quickly and be on our way. We will have a bus captain and an assistant. The bus will leave the race track around 6:45PM. You will need to back at the bus at that time, because we will not be able to wait for those arriving late. There is a shuttle service back to the bus from the main gate to make it easier to return to the bus. The bus should arrive back at Lake Sumter at 8:30PM. There is plenty of parking at the Lake Sumter Transportation.
