Prediction Row 2024



What is Prediction Row? The NASCAR season is 26 races long. Twelve club members sign up for the year and pick the winning driver for either the first 13 races or the second 13 races. On NASCAR race day, Prediction Row appears in the Sports Section of the Daily Sun. Our competitors simply predict who they think will win that day's race and

give a short reason. Our predictors are awarded the same points NASCAR awards the drivers and those points are accumulated throughout the segment. At the end of each of the 13 weeks, the top 3 (most wins predicted) will move on The Playoffs, which are the last 10 races of the season. That is it in a nutshell. There are only two qualifiers – you must be a club member and you must be able to participate via email.

Our predictors are taking warm-up laps and trash talking now but will begin in earnest with the Daytona 500 on February 18. Let me introduce you to the 2024 Prediction Row competitors.
