THE SON OF THE FAMED "SPEED KING" BREAKS DAD'S RECORD

Mickey Thompson, known as the "SPEED KING" in the 1960's, set the record with two weekend runs over 400 mph at Speed Week.

Not to be outdone, son Danny Thompson was clocked at over 402 mph in his Challenger 2 at Bonneville Salt Flats International Speedway on August 4, 2016. Despite Danny's mechanical problems, he was determined to break Bonneville's national speed record for piston-driven engines.

There are faster cars at Bonneville, but they are powered by rocket or jet engines, but Thompson's sleek blue streamliner is the classic piston-engine, which runs on a brew of nitro-methane and alcohol. This brew will average 0.1 miles per gallon!



And as you can see, it produces a noxious cloud of nitro and methanol as Danny Thompson starts his engines in the Challenger 2.

Thompson and his team have updated the framework of a car that his Dad had planned to race in 1968.



JAMES HINCHCLIFFE From IndyCar Driver To The Walking Dead



This 29 year old Canadian IndyCar Driver debuted his Indy Car career in 2011, and was awarded Indy Car Rookie of the Year and the Tony Roma Rising Star Award. Hinchcliffe has raced for Newman/Haas Racing, Andretti Autosport and is currently with Schmidt Peterson Motorsports.

Immediately after competing in the 2016 GoPro Grand Prix in Sonoma, which ended early Sunday Morning (September 18), he headed to Los Angeles. With only a day and a half to practice with his partner, Sharna Burgess, they preformed a Paso Doble to the theme song from Walking Dead. The judges scored them two points lower than last week saying he needs to work on his "spacing" and being less "vertical" as he moves.

Of course I don't believe any of this will be beneficial in his Indy Car.
