



## **BACON FRIED RICE**

1 pound bacon, cooked, drained and crumbled

3 cups water

2 cups rice

1 teaspoon olive oil

3 tablespoons butter

1 medium onion chopped

3 eggs

1 tablespoon soy sauce

1/2 teaspoon adobo seasoning

Bring water to a boil; add rice and olive oil. Reduce heat to low, cover and cook for about 20 minutes. In a large skillet, melt butter, stir in onion and cook until golden brown. Move onion to side of skillet and scramble eggs, Stir in soy sauce and adobo seasoning. When eggs are just about done, add rice and bacon. Stir to mix and serve hot.

Fried rice tip: To make this more of a main dish, add additional ingredients such as peas, chives, or any other item to add color.
